SHOW CONDITIONS

ALL ENTRIES TO BE BENCHED BY TIME NOTIFIED ON THE SHOW SCHEDULES

1. Entries are free to members of the Bankstown Orchid Society Inc only.
2. Entries will be received by the Show Marshall within the times advised on the Show Schedule.
3. Entries are received on the basis that the Society will take reasonable care of the exhibits, but shall not be responsible for any loss, destruction or damage to such exhibits. This also applies to sales table plants.
4. Judging shall be in accordance with the standards laid down by the Orchid Society of NSW and the judges decision shall be final
5. If, in the opinion of the judges in any class, no exhibit warrants a prize, none shall be given.
6. The exhibitor must have owned plants exhibited for at least six (6) months.
7. Plants shall not be removed from the Show before the termination of the said Show without prior permission of the Show Committee.
8. Staking shall be in accordance with the rules of the O.S.N.S.W. i.e flowers may be supported to the best possible manner for presentation. This supporting should be in such a manner so as not to be obtrusive and distract from the overall beauty and charm of the plant. With single flowered genera eg Paphiopedilum Lycaste etc, ties or supports shall be no higher than immediately below the ovary. If it is necessary to tie above the bottom flower or the top branch, the judges are permitted to penalize or temporarily remove such ties for the purpose of judging.
9. The President reserves the right to reject any plants or exhibits without giving any reason for such rejection.
10. All staging shall be under the supervision of the Show Committee.
11. The Exhibitor's name MUST NOT be visible on any plant
12. All plants will be judged in the respective classes as positioned by the Show Marshalls.
13. Exhibitors ONLY may sell plants. Maximum price is to be \$ 75.
14. Unknown plants on sales tables - Maximum price \$25. This includes coded plants.
15. Sales table commission will be 15% for those who assist with security and 20% for those who DO NOT assist with security.
16. Unknown plants must be tagged as such, or they will not be judged. This also applies with codes or numbers.
17. Plants exhibited as seedlings must be tagged and comprise the whole of the clone being flowered and exhibited for the first time.
18. All sales table plants must be tagged with the correct white plastic labels as available at Orchid meetings. Also initials and surname of the member is to be printed in full on the tag.
19. No plants for sale can be brought into the Show on the last day unless permission is sought from the Show Committee.
20. All plants exhibited or for sale must be disease free
21. Plants not in flower on the sales table should have a description of the flower on the tag.
22. No price alteration is allowed for the duration of the Show.
23. Classes will be added at the discretion of the Show Committee.
24. Members are required to wear name or society badges when setting up and dismantling. Please assist with security when ever possible.
25. Dismantling of each show will be notified on the Show Schedule
